





# How does Foundation Settlement Happen?

Foundation settlement is a major issue for homes across the Midwest, in one part because it's hard to see unless you go looking for it, and another being that Kansas City's soil is rich in clay.

Clay is an **expansive soil**, so it can soak up and retain substantial amounts of water. Kansas City's spring and fall seasons often see heavy rainfall, while their summers are, of course, much warmer and, therefore, drier.



If you are concerned that you might be dealing with your foundation settling, you can breathe a little easier, as you can address the symptoms of foundation settlement as long as you recognize them and seek the help of the foundation experts at KC Waterproofing and Foundation Repair.

You'll want to start by looking for signs of settlement around your home's interior and exterior

# **Helical/Push Piers**

Helical piers target problems deep within the earth's soil by transferring the weight of your property onto competent, load-bearing strata or bedrock using a helical pier to secure it in the ground. Push piers operate similarly but are hydraulically pushed into the soil and held in place by the structure.

## **Concentric vs Eccentric**

At KC Waterproofing we utilize both types of piers depending on the problem. Concentric tend to be best where support is needed in the middle of a slab or under a structure. Eccentric excel around the structure and holds substantially more weight.

### **Manifold**

We use a manifold lift system to ensure that foundations we lift happen concurrently to protect the existing foundation from additional bending and twisting. This provides an extra level of protection that other companies often do not provide.

# Why Do Walls Bow?

The fact that a wall can become so warped that it actually starts to bow is something that can leave you guessing about its cause, but the answer lies in foundation settlement. As your home's foundation settles, a lot of strain, known as hydrostatic pressure, begins to weigh down your basement walls. A home's walls can only hold on for so long, and eventually, they'll start to bow to that pressure.

Moisture changes in clay soil are the general culprit here, as they are the source of the pressure. When clay gets dry, it shrinks, but as it gets wet, it expands. This means that after a long period of drought, heavier rains can push walls inward as the soil rapidly expands. Though the process can happen anywhere, it's particularly important that Kansas City homeowners are aware of the issue, as the city's clay-rich soil increases its homes' chances of ending up with bowing walls.

Bowed walls don't just look unsightly; they can also be damaging to your home's structure and make for very unsafe conditions. Even worse, given that clay soil expels so much water, it can leak into your basement through even the faintest wall cracks, giving you another problem to deal with.

If you have block walls, you will see any bowing, usually from the middle, and you will likely also see horizontal or stair-step cracks on both sides of the wall. Stair-step cracks are exactly what they sound like — you'll see a crack that looks like a step on a staircase — and such cracks suggest the foundation is being pushed upward toward your home as a result of the hydrostatic pressure. These walls might also start to shear inward at the bottom block as they experience more pressure.

Poured walls will still show many of the hallmark signs of bowed walls (like bending or cracks), but they result in more leaning and tipping. In contrast with block walls, they bow near the top of the wall, leaning inward and developing diagonal cracks on both sides. So feel free to take a peek up top if you can't see anything at face level. Doing so can help confirm your suspicions and give you a better idea of the health of your foundation.

**Stone foundations** that suffer from bowing will act like both block and poured walls, but you'll be able to see the **bulging** or leaning from exterior walls. Stone foundations also vary in crack patterns, and those cracks could mean several things because they're made from various materials.

Regardless, it's always a safe bet to contact the professionals at KC Waterproofing if you suspect you have bowed walls. It's likely a signal that you have foundation issues we can fix!



An excellent choice for repairing a bowing wall is by using carbon fiber straps. Carbon fiber is a very lightweight, malleable material you can mold to fit virtually any shape. Carbon fiber straps can help brace and strengthen foundation walls with minor cracks and **bowing under two inches**. Although pliable, carbon fiber is up to 10 times stronger than steel.

Carbon fiber support is a great solution on poured and block walls in basements or crawl spaces. One of the outstanding features of carbon fiber is its minimally invasive and can be painted over or concealed behind drywall, virtually taking up no space in the process. It also requires no exterior excavation, is quick to install, and is an affordable option for bowing walls and cracked corners.

KC Waterproofing uses carbon fiber wall straps to stabilize cracked or bowed foundation walls to prevent further shifting. When caught early carbon fiber can strengthen existing walls, saving homeowners time and money.



# Bowing Wall Solution: Waler (AKA I-Beam)

One of the ways we can fix bowing walls is with an I-beam or waler. I-beams are strong and help many structures keep their shape. They're more beneficial for lateral movement and work well with stone, block, or poured walls, lasting a long time and able to be easily adjusted to fit whatever your home needs. Walers are five-inch beams that can be used to stabilize a foundation wall.

In construction, I-beams are called "universal beams," given how valuable and cost-effective they are for securing structures. Additionally, having an I-beam installed in a home that's struggling with buckling or bowing walls can make a world of difference!

# Bowing Wall Solution: Wall Anchors

You can correct a bowing wall with the help of wall anchors or tiebacks. These structures are useful for strengthening or straightening basement and retaining walls, with a specific design tailored to reduce the chances of the wall shifting from moving soil. The purpose of the wall anchor is to restore lateral strength to the wall, also allowing you to pull the wall straight using the natural expansion, and contraction of the soil.

These structures have so many different applications that they're often the answer to the more obscure wall problems. Tiebacks and anchors are also eco-friendly, cost-effective, and relatively simple to install.

Kansas City homes go through wet and dry cycles, which makes the ground expand when wet and pull away during dry weather.

# Noticing Water in Your Home?



# **Encapsulation Solutions**

Crawl space encapsulation is the recommended solution for vented dirt crawl spaces. You can rely on the KC Waterproofing team to take the same thorough approach we do to waterproofing basements to your crawl space to ensure everything is sealed tightly and protected.


**Vapor Barriers:** A vapor barrier is a white plastic like layer of protection that keeps moisture, radon, and mold out.

Interior Drainage: Our interior drainage tiles move water along the perimeter of your crawl space and directs them into the sump pump pit to be directed away from your foundation.

**Dehumidifier + Sump Pump:** Dehumidifiers pull moisture out of the air and surrounds and drains water into a sump pump which moves water away.

**Support Jacks:** Support jacks or posts provide structural stability to your crawl space joists, preventing and fixing uneven floors in your home.

**Crawl Space Doors:** Sealed crawl space doors grant access to your crawl space without allowing humid air to fill underneath your home.









# **What Causes Uneven Concrete?**

Uneven concrete around your home can be caused by a variety of reasons, but the main culprits are changing weather conditions and poor drainage. Since Kansas City has a high amount of clay in the soil, it's more susceptible to settling. Dry conditions cause clay soil to compact and wet soil to expand. The cycle of wet and dry periods eventually causes voids to form under concrete making the remaining soil unable to support the weight of concrete slabs. Uneven concrete is not only an eyesore, it's also a tripping hazard and can effect your home's curb appeal and resale value.

Mudjacking is heavy as well, adding additional weight to the slab causing more opportunity for it to sink in the future. 
